SAINT'S CORNER – ST. ANDREW (NOV. 30)

Andrew came from Bethsaida in Galilee. Like his father and his brother Simon, he was a fisherman. Andrew is known as the first disciple of Jesus. Later, when Jesus chose his apostles, Andrew was among the twelve. It is uncertain where Andrew preached or where he died, but ancient tradition associates him with Greece. He is a patron saint of Scotland and Russia, of the Greek Church and of the fishing industry.
